

Declaration that Products Supplied contain no Russian Iron or Steel

In light of recent announcements by the UK's Department for Business and Trade and the Department of International Trade, as well as corresponding EU authorities, stringent measures will take effect from 30th September 2023.

These measures pertain to the prohibition on the import of iron and steel products originating in Russia and/or processed in third countries. The aim is to curtail the circumvention of sanctions on the import of Russian iron and steel. There are no exceptions, and no transitional period is provided for any goods covered by these measures.

UK Regulations:

 - For the purpose of this sanction, a relevant 'iron and steel product' is defined as anything specified in Schedule 3b of the Russia Sanctions Regulations

Declaration:
